



Uniform Policy (Regular School Days)

A higher standard of dress encourages respect for individual students and results in a higher standard of behavior. The following items are part of the required school uniform for Renaissance Charter School at Cooper City. All students are expected to follow these guidelines. School uniforms are to be purchased exclusively from **Planet T** or **Red Apple Uniforms**. Please see the Renaissance Charter School at Cooper City (RCSCC) Parent Handbook for the full description details of our Uniform Policy.

Students in grades K-5:

- Red or Light Blue polo, short or long sleeved with school emblem
- Khaki or Navy bottoms (shorts, slacks, skorts)
- Gray PE T-Shirt and Navy-Blue PE Shorts (optional — can be worn on PE days only) with school emblem.

Students in grades 6-8:

- Navy Blue or White polo, short or long sleeved with school emblem
- Khaki or Navy bottoms (shorts or slacks)
- Gray PE T-Shirt and Navy-Blue PE shorts (required only if taking PE) with school emblem.

All Students:

- Solid black or brown belts are required (with the exception of Kindergarten)
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- If an undershirt is worn, it must be a Grey, Black, White, or Navy plain shirt.
- Shoes must be worn with Velcro closed or laces tied at all times. Closed toed with backs and NO boots. Anything over the ankle is considered a boot. No stacked or pumped shoes. No wheeled sneakers or pointed/cowboy boots.
- Fishnet stockings or other inappropriate leg wear is not acceptable. Socks should be worn no higher than lower calf length.
- Hair Styles: Hair must be kept neatly and evenly in a simple style. No fad-type styles, such as tails, Mohawks, spikes, head symbol shavings, carving marks, or unnatural colors (fluorescents, pink, red, blue, green, etc.) allowed. Hair should not obstruct the eyes. The decision about whether hair or make-up is appropriate will be at the Administration's discretion.
- No hats, bandanas, or headbands, including sports bands permitted. Foreheads must be exposed at all times.
- Jewelry should be kept to a minimum. Piercings only in ears permitted. Stud-style earrings are suggested and no more than one ring, necklace, and bracelet at a time.
- No facial make-up permitted. Only at dances. If a student wears make-up to school, they will be asked to remove it in the Main Office.
- Only approved outerwear with school emblem may be worn.
- No altering of the school uniform permitted. This includes rolling sleeves or bottoms from the top or hem.

In the event that your child has to start school without the required uniform, please staple a copy of your uniform order receipt to the inside of your child's agenda book. By doing this we understand that your child's uniform has been ordered and is on the way very shortly. While waiting for the order students must wear a Red polo shirt in elementary grades or a Navy polo shirt in the middle school grades along with Khaki shorts/slacks. No capris or skirts are allowed.
